

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we have been in regular contact with Kaseye Mission, sometimes several times a week. WhatsApp messages were by far the preferred means of communication, followed by emails and WhatsApp calls. #### ***Kaseye Community Hospital***

- Installation of a full-sized solar system, which greatly reduces the hospital's electricity bills. The overall project was funded through the German government through an application by Interplast Germany.
- Expenses for picking up, transporting and unloading of a container shipped from Tanzania
- Construction of a concrete pad for the five containers shipped from Germany
- Reimbursement of cost for a container lifter to unload two containers
- Construction of a Waiting Mothers' House
- Renovation of the Outpatient Department
- Isolation tent
- Toilets and showers for isolation tent
- Perimeter wall around Kaseye Community Hospital
- Renovation of pre/postnatal wards
- Renovation of Delivery Room
- Renovation of a dilapidated building of the Kaseye Girls' Primary School into a Communication Centre (used by hospital, primary school and secondary school)
- Donation of medications
- In-kind donations of medical equipment and supplies; delivery beds and laundry equipment; CABC website

#### ***Kaseye Girls' Primary School***

- Construction of a new school kitchen
- Construction of dining hall
- 250 student desks and 10 tables and chairs for teachers

#### ***CABC Scholarship Fund***

A total of 25 Malawians, some studying outside of Malawi, were supported:

- Nineteen students in Malawi; 2 students graduated in 2020 with diploma in clinical medicine, 1 with diploma in accountancy
- Three students in Zambia: (one student earned a diploma in dentistry in 2020)
- One student in Tanzania
- One sister in Kenya (Bachelor's degree in pastoral theology in 2020)
- One Sister in the USA
- In-Kind contribution of gently used computers
